THOMPSON ATTENDS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE

WYNNE - Brian Thompson, director of external affairs for the Cross County Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Corp., recently completed Year I of the Community Development Institute (CDI). The 22nd annual CDI session was held at the University of Central Arkansas, Aug. 4- 8. The complete institute experience involves progressing through a curriculum of more than 100 hours with corporate, academic and governmental professionals serving as faculty.

Teamwork Arkansas, the economic development office of Entergy Arkansas, awarded Thompson with a grant to attend the Institute.
